DG SBP Zulfigar Ghumman inspects all arrangements before the start of first Pak-World XI T20 match

LAHORE: (Sept 12, 2017): Director General Sports Punjab Zulfiqar Ahmed Ghumman, on Tuesday inspected CC TV Control Room, Emergency Response Centre and 20-bed makeshift hospital in Nishtar Park Sports Complex before the start of first T20 match between Pakistan and World XI T20 at Gaddafi Stadium.

Director General Sports Punjab Zulfiqar Ahmed Ghumman issued necessary instructions to staff concerned to avoid any inconvenience during the high-voltage cricket clash.
